

School Uniform, PE Kit etc.

At Long Furlong we have a school uniform which all pupils are expected to wear. Please label all items of school uniform with your child's name.

Grey skirt/trousers/shorts/culottes
White blouse/polo shirt/shirt
Burgundy school sweatshirt*/burgundy cardigan*
Burgundy school hoody**
Socks/Tights (white, black or grey)
School shoes/sandals[†]

Summer option: pink & white dress

Items of clothing required for cultural or religious reasons (e.g.patka, hijab, kippah, etc) may be worn in school.

* Sweatshirts and cardigans may be ordered via the school office, direct through our suppliers www.brigade.uk.com or through Tesco online (go to <http://www.clothingattesco.com/>, select "School Uniform" and "Uniform Embroidery Service".)

** Pupils are allowed to wear burgundy hoodies on the way to and from school, for outdoor morning and lunchtime play, for outdoor PE, for school sporting events and on school trips. Pupils are not permitted to wear hoodies in the classroom and should instead wear their school sweatshirt or cardigan.

[†]**Footwear:** should be shoes (*not* trainers or boots) and be black, navy or a dark colour with enclosed heels and toes. Sandals may be worn in the summer, these can be black, navy or white with a secure strap. Heels should not be higher than 4cm. Please label your child's shoes with his or her name.

PE/Sport: children should have black shorts and plain white T-shirt for PE, and dark coloured tracksuit trousers/jogging bottoms and a plain dark coloured hooded sweatshirt or school hooded sweatshirt for **outdoor PE only** in the **winter** months. For outdoor PE they require trainers.

Earrings/Jewellery: the children are discouraged from wearing jewellery to school apart from a wristwatch. Your child may wear a small stud or sleeper. However, it is important that, even with Reception age children, they are able to manage the insertion and removal of their earrings independently. If you feel that your child is unable to do this, please do not let them wear earrings to school. Following Local Authority health & safety guidelines, teachers will not remove children's earrings. During PE/sport sessions it will not be acceptable for your child to wear earrings unless they are newly pierced (within a seven-week period) in which case they will be covered with surgical tape.

Accessories: plain hairbands, clips and hair ties may be worn. We discourage hair braiding/beads. Pupils are not permitted to wear nail polish in school.
