<p><b>Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.</b></p> <p><i>Pupils are 'meeting the expected standard' if they achieve a 'scaled score' of 100 or more in their Reading and Maths tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at the expected standard' or better in Writing.</i></p>	64%	64%	65%
<p><b>Average progress in Reading</b></p> <p><i>The scores are calculated by comparing the Key Stage 2 test and assessment results of pupils at this school with the results of pupils in schools across England who started with similar assessment results at the end of the previous key stage – Key Stage 1.</i></p> <p><i>A score above zero means pupils made more progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.</i></p> <p><i>A score below zero means pupils made less progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.</i></p> <p><i>A negative progress score does not mean pupils made no progress, or the school has failed, rather it means pupils in the school made less progress than other pupils across England with similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.</i></p> <p><i>The majority of schools have progress scores between -5 and +5.</i></p>	-0.52	0.06	0.03

<p><b>Percentage of pupils achieving a high level of attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths</b></p> <p><i>Pupils are 'achieving at a higher standard' if they achieve a 'scaled score' of 110 or more in their Reading and Maths tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at a greater depth within the expected standard' in Writing.</i></p>	11%	11%	11%
<p><b>Average scaled score in Reading</b></p> <p><i>The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.</i></p>	104.3	104.7	104.4
<p><b>Average scaled score in Maths</b></p> <p><i>The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.</i></p>	103.7	104.7	105
